She has been taking care of patients in the nursing home for over eight years and during some of that time was running a program for patients with substance use disorder on treatment with buprenorphine who required SNF/LTC placement. Amelia is on the Maine Clinical Opioid Advisory Board and working with a HRSA grant on expanding access for patients with substance use disorder to SNF/LTC services in Maine.
